Phd researcher needed for ARC Discovery project

Faculty of Arts: Centre for the History of European Discourses

Applications are invited for the above position, which is funded by an ARC Discovery Grant awarded to Professor Peter Cryle, Director of the Centre for the History of European Discourses.

The Centre conducts research into selected key European cultural and intellectual traditions. Rather than focusing on ideas, the Centre is concerned with the discourses in which thought is formulated, the purposes envisaged for such discourses, the networks in which they circulated, and the larger cultural and political contexts in which they functioned.

Applicants should have a PhD or equivalent qualification completed no more than five years prior to application in one of the following fields: history of sexuality, history of medicine, gender theory or queer studies. A demonstrated ability to complete research projects and to publish is also required.

The appointment is fixed term for three years, the successful applicant will be required to take up the appointment on 31 January 2005, or on a date to be negotiated. The remuneration package will be in the range of \$52,929.91 to \$64,466.06 per annum, including employer superannuation contributions of 17%.
